

DESCRIPTIONS OF COMMITTEES

Following are brief overviews of what types of help is needed for each committee. Do as much or as little as you like. ALL time and effort IS appreciated!

Uniforms – Assist with fittings, keeping order in the closet, provide assistance to students on game nights (i.e. – monitor dressing rooms, hand out accessories), sort uniforms.

Bleacher Covers – Assist before and after games in setting up bleacher covers at all games.

Pit Crew – Assist loading/unloading and moving percussion equipment during games and contests.

Magazine Sales – Coordinate with directors the sales packets, money collection, submit orders.

Fundraising – Assist with organizing fundraising events for the band.

Bus Riders – A minimum of 10 riders are needed each bus trip the band makes. To rest any fears – the kids are really good and all you really are is a ‘presence.’ The student Bus Captains maintain order. District policy states that we have 2 adults per bus. It’s a free ride to the games!!!

Merchandise Sales – Help work The Band Stand sales booth at home games, booster meetings and other special events.

Publicity/Council of Clubs Rep – Attend occasional meetings at THS as band rep, provide Band article for THS newsletter, contact HEB website and local publications with Band news and announcements.

Silent Auction/Concert – Coordinate donations for silent auction and/or organize fundraising meal on auction night.

Video Tape Games – Video tape half-time shows from announcer booth. Bideo is usually shown immediately after the game (at CiCi's) and the directors use it for assessment.

Cookie Sales – Help bake and sell Otis cookies during two 1-week periods. Usually in January and February.

Arbor Daze – Work THS Band booth selling drinks at Euless Arbor Daze festival in April. This is a fundraiser for the band.

Button Mums – Take orders and help make decorated photo buttons using student band photos.

Hospitality/Spirit Décor – Assist in organizing receptions after concerts, help create and put up banners and decorations.
